



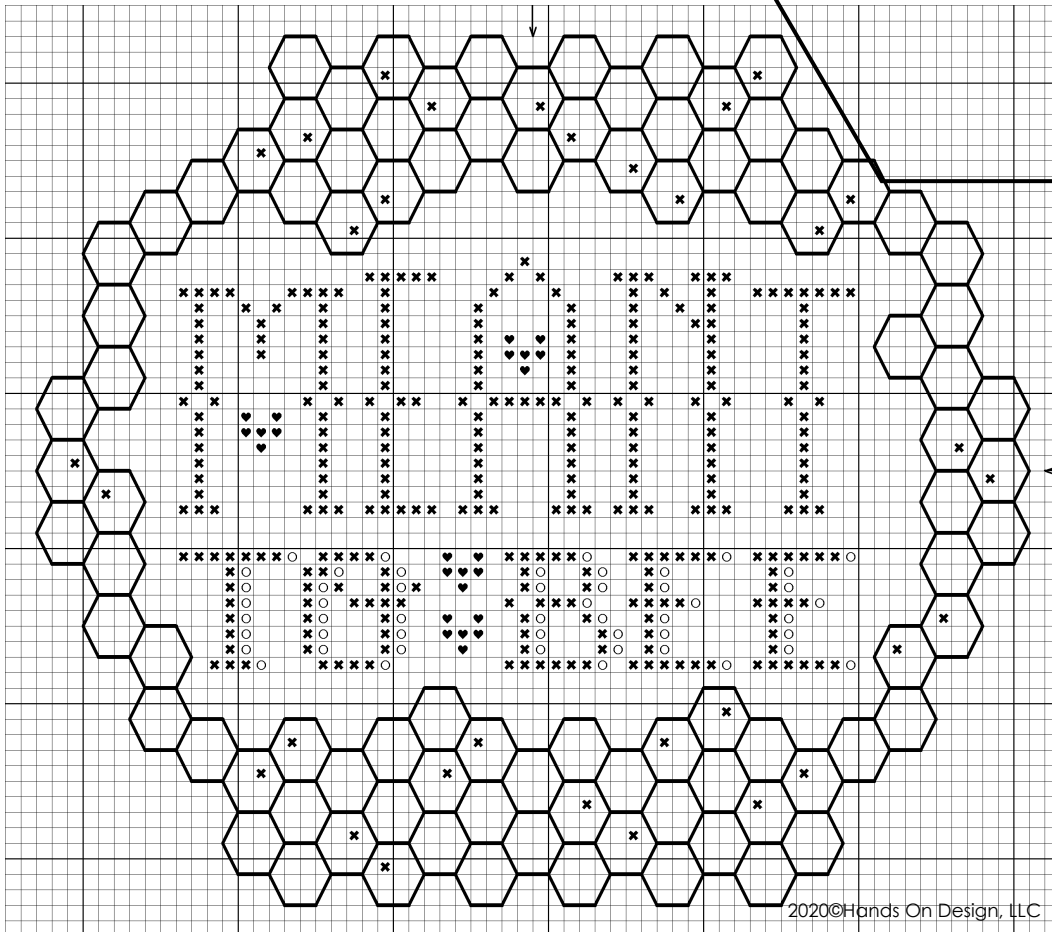
Meant to Bee

Cathy, Hands On Design

- Model stitched on 32ct Weeks Dye Works Putty with WDW Flatfish, Gold & Aztec Red—use my colorway or create your own! Honeycomb lines were stitched in 2 strands Gold.
- Lady Dot Rick Rack—Mossy
- Just Another Button Company: Bee Sweet Pin-Mini jpm486 & Bee-normous button pack #10473
- Finishing: apply featherweight iron on fusible interfacing to the back of the stitching.
- Trace hexagonal pattern provided onto tissue paper. Cut out & lay over stitching. Trace outline onto stitching. The stitched honeycomb will run off the edge of the cushion.
- Sew Lady Dot rock rack at outline. Place stitching & coordinating cotton right sides together & sew all around.
- Trim corners, cut a slit through the cotton back, turn, press, stiff & close slit with a ladder stitch. Apply fabric with double sided fusible & attach some fun buttons!!

Hexagon should measure 4" wide at farthest point



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
