


Gobble On!—it's time for turkey!

- Model stitched on 30ct Pumpkin: 88x23. Baker's twine & woolfelt penny included. You will need linen, finishing fabrics, & DMC floss (400, 3810, 3347, 921).
- Center & stitch the letters with 2-ply 400 (brown). (the "o" has been charted for spacing or if you do not wish to use the woolfelt penny)
- Stitch the turkey feathers in the orange green & teal floss according to the picture (& the turkey legs in 400)



- Woolfelt turkey penny: Place the brown penny in the 'o' spot on the orange linen. With 2-ply 400, bring needle up through the orange linen, just next to the edge of the penny. Make a straight stitch approx 1/8-1/4" deep into the penny & down through the linen. Bring needle back up through linen, approx 1/8-1/4" away from the previous perpendicular stitch. Continue this around the circle keeping stitches evenly spaced & deep. Knot at the end.
- Iron lightweight fusible web to back side of stitched piece. Draw a line on back side approx 1/2" away from image on the top & sides & 1/4" away from the bottom edge.
- Place the smaller piece of cotton fabric, right sides together, along the bottom edge & sew along the guideline. Turn, trim & press towards the cotton side. Trim cotton fabric to approx 1 3/8"
- With right side together sew stitched piece to backing fabric along stitching line, leaving an opening at the bottom.
- Trim corners, turn & press. Stuff & slip stitch bottom closed. Wrap bakers twine around pillow twice & make a bow!
